DAY	CITY	ACTIVITY DETAILS
Day 1	Athens	<p>Arrival</p> <p>Private Transfer from Airport to Hotel</p>
Day 2	Athens	<p>SIC FD Athens City Tour with Cape Sounio</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guided tour highlighting the striking contrasts of Athens. • Short stop at the Panathenaic Stadium, venue of the first modern Olympic Games in 1896. • Panoramic drive past the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, Hellenic Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Academy of Athens, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, National Library of Greece, and Syntagma Square. • Visit to the Acropolis of Athens including the Propylaea, Temple of Athena Nike, Erechtheion and the Parthenon. • Explore the Acropolis Museum and admire classical masterpieces. • Lunch at a local restaurant. • Scenic coastal drive passing Glyfada, Vouliagmeni and Varkiza with views of the Saronic Gulf. • Visit to Cape Sounion and the Temple of Poseidon. • Free time to walk along the rocky promontory before returning.
Day 3	Athens	<p>SIC Full day Delphi Tour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive through the fertile plain of Beotia, crossing the towns of Thebes connected with the tragedy of King Oedipus - Levadia and Arachova (short stop on the way back). • Arrive at Delphi, the center of the Ancient World - the "Omphalos" (Navel of Earth) - whose prestige extended far beyond the boundaries of the Hellenic World. On the slopes of Mount Parnassus, in a landscape of unparalleled beauty and majesty, lie the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios.

		Visit the Treasury of the Athenians, the Temple of Apollo and the Museum containing such masterpieces of Ancient Greek sculpture as the bronze Charioteer and the famous athlete Aghias. Return to Athens by the same route.
Day 4	Mykonos	Transfer Transfer from Athens to Mykonos
Day 5	Mykonos	Private City and Island Tour <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore the charming streets of Mykonos, visit the famous Mykonos Windmills and see Petros the Pelican. • Discover traditional villages including Ano Mera and the Monastery of Panagia Turliani. • Relax at Kalafatis Beach and drive past Ornos Beach and Agios Ioannis Beach. • End with panoramic views over Mykonos Town and the surrounding islands.
Day 6	Santorini	Transfer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transfer from Mykonos Hotel to Mykonos Airport • Transfer from Santorini Airport to Santorini Hotel
Day 7	Santorini	Archeological Site of Akrotiri <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit to the Archeological Site of Akrotiri with a licensed Guide - The settlement was destroyed in the Thera eruption sometime in the 16th century BC and buried in volcanic ash, which preserved the remains of fine frescoes and many objects and artworks. Akrotiri has been excavated since 1967 after earlier excavations on Santorini. • After this visit to an underground Wine Museum, where you will get to taste four local wines. • A visit to the Light House also is included and if time permits we can stop for lunch next to the sea, at the Black Beach.
Day 8	Santorini	Free Day <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day free for leisure and relaxing
Day 9	Crete	Transfer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transfer from Santorini Hotel to Santorini Airport • Transfer from Crete Airport to Crete Hotel
Day 10	Crete	Knossos

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knossos Palace: On this excursion, you have the opportunity to visit the excavation sites of the Palace of Knossos, built in 2000 BC. Knossos was the prosperous Minoan Capital and the residence of King Minos. Some believe that the intricate Palace with its many rooms was the mythical labyrinth. By discovering the site not too long ago, archaeologists found the first advanced civilizations in Europe. <p>Archeological Museum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Archeological Museum: The tour is followed by a visit to the Museum of Heraklion, where you can see the largest collection of Minoan findings from Crete. <p>Heraklion city</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be time to visit the market, the shops and have lunch and a visit to the Venetian port of Heraklion and the old castle Koules is built on two tiers and offers a commanding view of Heraklion from the battlements. Walking in the old town, we reach St. Titus' Cathedral, an impressive sight. The Loggia is a wonderful example of a Venetian building.
